## Summer Educational Enrichment in Math (SEE-Math 2025)

Dear Math Student,

Do you think math is fun? Come join our <u>Summer Educational Enrichment in Math (SEE-Math)</u> program this summer and "SEE" how much fun mathematics can be. You will learn how to create animated movies on a computer, count in complicated situations, color a map, count infinities, solve logical puzzles, make and break codes, and many other interesting problems. You might also like to take part in our problem contests and win a prize!! Some of these topics may not seem like mathematics to you, but they actually are! Think about these interesting situations:

\*If I say "I'm lying," am I really lying or telling the truth?

\*Order these sets by size: all real numbers, all integers, all rational numbers.

\*Can you use dominos to cover all the squares of a checkerboard except for two diagonally opposite corners?

SEE Math is a two-week commuter program that runs July 14 to July 25, 2025 from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. Transportation to Texas A&M University **must** be provided by your family each day. Out-of-town participants often rent a hotel or Airbnb. The sessions will be conducted by faculty and grad students in the Math Department at Texas A&M University with the help of A&M math students and former *SEE-Math* participants. The program is partially funded by the Math Department and Texas A&M University. Our primary goal is to help you find excitement in the discovery of mathematics and science concepts, and to provide you with the knowledge and confidence to continue your studies in math and science related fields.

You are eligible to participate in *SEE-Math* if you will be entering 6th, 7th or 8th grade in the fall of 2025 and have not done SEE-Math in the past. Enrollment will be limited to about 50 students. There will be a charge of \$150 for each participant collected after you are accepted. However, the fee may be reduced or waived for anyone for whom it would be a financial hardship. Note that if the fee is not used up during *SEE-Math* it will be used for other outreach activities during the year or to pay the organizers. Fill out the online application at <u>http://see-math.math.tamu.edu/2025/</u> and have your teacher fill out the recommendation form. There are continuous applications. Acceptances will begin **February 15, 2025** and continue while space is available.
